

**“Low Emission Future” selected as Top Paper in ES&T
Climate Change**

The publication of Glen Peters (Norwegian University of Science and Technology) and coauthors in the journal, Environmental Science and Technology (ES&T) has been identified as the top paper of the journal in 2007.

In their study (G. Peters et al., *Environ. Sci. Tech.*, **2007**, *41* (17), 5939–5944) they find that the Chinese have taken steps to improve their energy efficiency and still travel mainly on bicycles, a sustainable, zero-emissions mode of transport. “Key to this paper was a desire to provide insight into how other developing countries can develop a low-emissions future, the authors note.
